

Information on the Master's entrance exam Computer Science and Media Informatics

What to expect on your exam day

On the day of the exam, you will receive your test booklet and answer sheet in the exam hall. We will guide you through the whole process and provide detailed instructions before the exam begins.

The exam duration is 90 minutes.

How to prepare for the exam

Exam structure and grading

You will need to solve multiple-choice tasks based on the specified topics.

- Each task has several possible answer choices. One or more (but never all) of them may be correct.
- Each task indicates how many points will be awarded if completed correctly. You will find this information in brackets after each task.

Scoring: You will earn partial points for each correctly selected answer choice. You will earn full points for a task if all correct answer choices are selected. Please note that incorrectly selected answer choices will be deducted from the correct ones. However, you cannot score less than zero points per task.

Filling out the answer sheets

Correct answers must be marked with an "X" on the answer sheet. Markings and notes outside the designated boxes will not be considered in the automated evaluation and may affect readability. Markings in the test booklet will also not be considered.
